IMI performed the mechanical and general trades work for the renovation of the Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighter Training burn pit. IMI removed and replaced the propane piping, the burners, and the associated concrete and stone work. The facility was the first of its kind in the U.S. capable of providing "wet bath" training scenarios. It is controlled by a state of the art computer system that creates realistic fuel spill training conditions.
